AGL, GE and CATCON power ahead with Silverton Wind Farm Project

CATCON are pleased to announce today that CATCON have been selected by AGL in partnership with GE to construct the \$450 million Silverton Wind Farm.

The Silverton Wind Farm is the first greenfield project under the Powering Australian Renewables Fund (PARF), a partnership between AGL, QIC and Future Fund for the development 1,000MW of large-scale renewable energy projects.

The 58 GE 3.4MW wind turbines will be the largest in Australia, with rotors spanning 130-metres. Once operational the wind farm will generate approximately 780,000 MWh of energy annually, enough to power more than 136,000 average Australian homes. *

GE and CATCON have been named as the successful tenderer for the engineering procurement contract at Silverton, forming a Consortium, to develop the Wind Farm, which is targeted to be fully operational by the middle of 2018.

GE and CATCON, will be responsible for the engineering, procurement and construction of the Silverton Wind Farm Project, which includes the supply, transportation, erection, fit-out and commissioning of 58 No. wind generation turbines, together with the design and construction of the WTG foundations, internal road and hardstand network, electrical reticulation system, external road upgrades and the construction of an Operations and Maintenance Facility.

CATCON CEO, Steve Moreau, said "we congratulate AGL and the PARF partnership on achieving financial close for this significant Renewable Energy Project and together with our joint venture partner, GE, the world's Digital Industrial Company, look forward to collaborating with AGL and the local community at Silverton to successfully construct this National Scale Wind Farm Project".
